Heavy Horse Judging - to be judged on type, ride, manners and conformation. Horses should be sound, of breed type, have substance, good bone, correct conformation, presence and true action. Heavy Horses should be judged in the same procedure as Hunters. Horses should be well schooled and attention should be paid to manners.

Phase 1 Manners & Way of Going within Breed Type or Judges Ride Marks out of 50

Emphasis should be on judging on action, well balanced, obedient ride that is comfortable to sit on. When scoring Ride Judges should take into account the Initial Go Round

Phase 2 Conformation, Type, Freedom of Action Marks out of 50

Conformation, Soundness, Type and Action should be judged on the individual breed criteria
