Do I need to be a TSR Member?

You **DO NOT** have to be a TSR Member to enter.

How do I Enter?

Entries go to the show hosting the final not to TSR. Either enter before the show by online or post OR enter at the show (by 4.30pm the day before the class).

How are the FINALS judged?

The TSR Finals will be judged using the following Mark System. The Performance Judge will award up to 30 Marks for Performance & up to 30 marks for the Riders/Handlers Skill. The conformation judge will award up to 30 marks for Conformation & 10 for Turnout.

Stallions - Junior riders of stallions not exc 138cm must be 12 years & over & Junior Riders on stallions exc 138cm must be 14 years & over (please see TSR Rule book). Coloured Stallions MUST be graded & have a Stallion Disc to be eligible to compete

- Class 430 **TSR IN HAND M&M SMALL BREEDS** – colt, filly, stallion, mare or gelding, any age, to be registered with the relevant pure bred Breed Society Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B. 1st placed rosettes to highest placed of each breed.
- Class 431 **TSR IN HAND M&M LARGE BREEDS** – colt, filly, stallion, mare or gelding, any age, to be registered with the relevant pure bred Breed Society Highland, Fells, Dales, Connemara, New forest, Welsh C & D. 1st placed rosettes to highest placed of each breed.
- Class 432 **TSR IN HAND HORSE / PONY** – colt, filly, stallion, mare or gelding, any age, any height. 1st - 10th for Ponies & 1st - 10th for horses plus 1st rosettes to highest placed of each type of horse and pony.

**TSR IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP** - 1st & 2nd compete from classes 430 -432

- Class 433 **TSR RIDDEN COLOURED HORSE / PONY - ANY TYPE** – 4 years old & over, any height, sex, any type inc spots (duns, palominos not eligible). Stallions MUST be graded and wear a Stallion Disc to be eligible to enter see TSR Rule Book. Riders any age to be suitably mounted. Junior riders of stallions not exc 138cm must be 12 years & over & Junior Riders on stallions exceeding 138cm must be 14 years & over (please see TSR Rule Book). *Overall Rosette 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> PLUS 1st to 10th Rosettes for Plaited Type & 1st to 10th Rosettes for Native/Trad/Cob type*

- Class 434 **TSR RIDDEN PONY** – 4 years old & over, not exc 153cms, any type/sex. Riders any age to be suitably mounted (please see TSR rule on Juniors riding stallions) 1st Rosettes to the highest placed Show Pony, Hunter Pony, PC/RC Type & Junior/Senior Rider.
- Class 435 **TSR RIDDEN HORSE including COBS** – 4 years old & over, any height/sex, any type. Riders any age to be suitably mounted. Rosettes to the highest placed Hack, Riding Horse, Hunter, Ex Race Horse, PC/RC type & Junior Rider. 1st - 10th Rosettes for Ridden Cobs (no extra prize money for cobs).
- Class 436 **TSR M&M - JUNIOR RIDER** 4 years old & over, open to registered & unregistered Welsh A,B, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Shetland, Welsh C, D, Highlands, Fells, Dales, Connemara, New Forest. Riders to be 15 years & under at time of entry, to be suitably mounted. (Please see TSR rule on Juniors riding stallions). 1st Rosettes to the highest placed of each breed.
- Class 437 **TSR M&M – SENIOR RIDER** – 4 years old & over, open to registered & unregistered Welsh A,B, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Shetland, Welsh C, D, Highlands, Fells, Dales, Connemara, New Forest. *Riders to be 16 years & over at time of entry*, suitably mounted. 1st Rosettes to the highest placed of each breed.
- Class 438 **TSR VETERAN/SENIOR HORSE OR PONY** – any height, any type & sex. Horses to be 15 years & over. Riders any age to be suitably mounted. (Please see TSR rule on Juniors riding stallions). *1st Rosettes to the highest placed 15-18yrs, 19-24yrs & 24 yrs+. Rosette to highest placed Junior Rider.*
- Class 439 **TSR WALK & TROT SHOWING** – To be judged on the riders ability and the performance & presentation of the horse/pony, conformation will not be taken into account. Mare or gelding 4 years & over any type/height, rider any age to be suitably mounted. Lead reins eligible.
- Class 440 **TSR LEAD REIN** – Any Type (Plaited & M&M) 4 years old & over mare or gelding, not exceeding 128cms, any plaited type. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday by 1st January in the current year. *Overall Rosette 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> PLUS 1st to 6<sup>th</sup> Rosettes to the highest placed M&M types & 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Plaited Types.*
- Class 441 **TSR FIRST RIDDEN ANY TYPE (PLAITED & M&M)** – 4 years old & over mare or gelding, not exceeding 128cms, any plaited type. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year. *Overall Rosette 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> PLUS 1st to 6<sup>th</sup> Rosettes to the highest placed M&M types & 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> Plaited Types.*
- Class 442 **TSR RC / PC TYPE HORSE/PONY** – 4 years old & over. Any height / type/sex. Rider any age and suitably mounted (please see TSR rule on Juniors riding stallions) To be judged on the suitability of the horse/pony as a good all-rounder, will not be required to jump. 1st Rosettes to the highest placed horse/pony & Junior Rider.

**TSR MEMBERS SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP** Highest placed TSR Member from classes 430 - 442 to compete after the last TSR Class has finished. Presentation during the Evening Performance.
