

EQUIFEST SHOW RULES

GENERAL SHOW RULES

- 1 **ENTRY FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AFTER THE CLOSE OF ON LINE ENTRIES** – even with a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate. Exhibitors wishing to request a refund of entry fees must apply in writing by midnight on the **29th July 2022**.
- 2 **NO ENTRIES OR SUBSTITUTIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE ON LINE ENTRIES (midnight 29th July 2022.)** and the catalogue has gone to print.
- 3 **THE PERSON WHO SUBMITS THE ENTRY FORM EITHER BY POST OR ON LINE** is deemed to be the owner / exhibitor of that entry.
- 4 **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY FULL PAYMENT.**
- 5 **THE SUBMISSION OF ALL ENTRIES THROUGH THE ON LINE SYSTEM** signifies acceptance of all Equifest rules and conditions.
- 6 **AMENDMENTS OF ENTRIES** – entries will be amended free of charge up to the close of on line entries. After this date any amendments must be made at the show. All amendments made at the show will incur a **£5** administration fee.
- 7 **REPRESENTED CHEQUES** – any payment that has to be represented to the bank for whatever reason will be subjected to a **£20.00** administration fee for each occasion.
- 8 **CANCELLATION OF / OR ALTERATION TO CLASSES** - The Equifest Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, divide or amalgamate or otherwise change any class or to limit entries in any class or section from any entrant.
- 9 **COMPETITOR NUMBERS MUST BE WORN / CLEARLY** displayed at all times whilst mounted. This includes working in / exercising around the showground.
- 10 **ALL RIDDEN / DRIVEN ANIMALS MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER.** The age of the animal shall be calculated from the 1st January in the year of its birth.
- 11 **ALL EQUINES MUST BE LED, RIDDEN OR DRIVEN AND UNDER THE CONTROL** of a competent person at all times. Handlers of Lead Rein ponies must be at least **14** years of age. Junior Drivers (under the age of **14** years old) **MUST** have a competent person in the vehicle with them at all times. Failure to observe any of the rules may result in disqualification of the animal concerned and/or the Exhibitor may be requested to leave the showground.
- 12 **CONTAGIOUS DISEASE** – All equines must be vaccinated against Equine Flu according. The last vaccination should have been given within 12 months of the date of the show. Spot checks on passports may be carried out.
- 13 **EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO CARRY PASSPORTS** for all horses/ponies when competing or travelling. Competitors are reminded that it is a Trading Standards requirement that the passport must be in the name of the legal owner.
- 14 **NO BEHAVIOUR OF AN OFFENSIVE, ABUSIVE OR UNPLEASANT MANNER** to any person at Equifest will be tolerated. Any act of discourtesy to any Judge, Steward or any Show Official on the part of the competitor groom, rider, driver or agent of an animal, will, at the discretion of such Official disqualify that animal from being judged, in which case entry fees, prizes and charges will be forfeited. **Exhibitors are reminded of their responsibility for the actions of others within their party. All belongings should be securely kept locked up. No responsibility by the Equifest Committee can be taken for theft or damage to belongings left unattended.**
- 15 **THE EQUIFEST COMMITTEE RETAINS AT ITS ABSOLUTE DISCRETION THE RIGHT** to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign reason or being liable for any compensation.
- 16 **NO PERSON SHALL ILL-TREAT ANIMALS AT ANY TIME** whether by misuse/excessive use of a whip, bit or any item of saddlery or in any other way whatsoever.
- 17 **DOGS** - For reasons of safety and to prevent nuisance the Council of the Society has decided that dogs can only be permitted on the Showground whilst on a lead. Exhibitors **MUST** clean up after their dogs. Any person found to disregard this rule will be fined. Lost dogs will be compounded and will not be released until a payment of **£20** is made. All payments will be donated to an animal charity of our choice. Dogs must be kept under control at all times whilst on the showground.
- 18 **MOTOR BIKES, QUAD BIKES & HOVER BOARDS** will **NOT** be permitted on the Showground.
- 19 **BICYCLES & SCOOTERS** will be allowed on the Showground but must **NOT** be ridden during Show hours around any rings or in specified horse areas. This includes the Indoor Arena and Collecting Rings.

- 20 AGE OF RIDERS / JUNIOR MEMBERS** – is taken from the 1st January in the current year unless stated otherwise in the schedule. All riders competing in any showing class must have attained their 3rd birthday by the date of the show.
- 21 PRIVATELY OWNED BUGGIES / HIRED BUGGIES** – may **NOT** be driven around the showground – unless an exemption has been granted **in writing** by the Equifest Committee. Only exhibitors with a medical disability will be granted dispensation. All persons must have a valid, full UK Driving License to drive any buggy or other motorised vehicle on the showground. Disabled visitors may bring their own buggies onto the Showground – but must have appropriate insurance.
- 24 OBJECTIONS** – Any exhibitor at the show feeling himself aggrieved must make his protest in writing within one hour of the completion of the judging of the class and pay a deposit to the Show Secretary of £50.00. Objections will not be entertained from any person or organisation not exhibiting in the same class as the animal to which the objection is raised. An Appeal Tribunal will consider objections at a time and place to be fixed by them and the person making the objection must be available to attend should it be deemed necessary. The decision of the Appeal Tribunal shall be final and if the protest is not substantiated the deposit will be forfeited

INSURANCE:

- (a) It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure all property and livestock on the Showground or elsewhere which is his own, or for which he is responsible.
- (b) The Society requires exhibitors to affect Employers Liability insurance where this is required by statute.
- (c) The Society also requires affecting Public Liability and Products Liability insurance with a minimum indemnity of £1,000,000 to protect their liability.

JUDGING OF CLASSES, TACK & CLOTHING

- 25 THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
- 26 JUDGING TIMES** are as accurate as possible at the time of printing, but it is advisable to check with the revised timetable nearer to the Show. Judging is in timetable order unless otherwise stated.
- 27 PRE-JUDGING** - In all cases where pre-judging is scheduled, it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to report to the Ring at the appointed time. **Exhibitors who do not participate in the pre-judging will not be allowed to compete in the final judging during the Evening Performance.**
- 28 JUDGING OF CLASSES** – no animal or rider may leave the ring without permission of the Judge and Ring Steward. Once the class has commenced there shall be no change of rider, except in a championship when a rider finds that they have more than one exhibit to compete. The substitute rider must be eligible for the class and the Ring Steward informed of the change of rider.
- 29 FALL OF HORSE / RIDER** – a fall of horse or rider while mounted in any class will result in disqualification and they **MUST** leave the ring dismounted.
- 30 LOOSE HORSES** – If an animal gets loose from its handler whilst in the Ring or during the Conformation phase of any Working Hunter / Working Hunter Pony class it will result in disqualification.
- 31 CLOSING OF CLASS** – no exhibits will be permitted to enter the class once the gate is closed and the horses / ponies have been asked to trot.
- 32 EXHIBITORS** may not knowingly exhibit a pony that has been bred, sold, leased, produced, broken, ridden or trained by the Judge and/or his/her immediate family or his/her employer or anyone with whom he/she resides with the exception of Show Jumping competitions since **1st August 2019**.
- 33 JUDGES** may not knowingly judge a horse/pony that has been owned, produced, exhibited, bred or ridden by them or by anyone with whom they are in a business/personal partnership with or by anyone they employ or by anyone who employs them since 1st August 2019.
- 34 ALL RIDE JUDGES** must wear a correctly secured hat to the approved current BSI standard at all times whilst mounted. Any Ride Judge who falls or is thrown whilst judging may not continue to ride the exhibits or ride judge any further exhibits until passed as fit by the medical team. If the Judge is capable of continuing his / her duties then all exhibits in the class must give an individual show (including any exhibit previously ridden). In the event that the Judge is not capable of continuing, an appropriately qualified replacement may be appointed.
- 35 HATS** – correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats that meet current BSI safety standards of: PAS 015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards **MUST** be worn by all riders. In the Evening Performances (and any associated pre-judging) Top Hats or Bowlers may be worn by riders that are **18** years and over **AT THEIR OWN RISK**. All riders 18 years old & over who wish to wear a hat that does not reach the current BSI standards during the Evening Performances **MUST** sign a hat disclaimer form obtainable

from the Show Office **before** the Evening Performance. Handlers of horses / ponies competing in Handler / In Hand classes aged 14 years & under must wear a secured current BSI standard Skull / Riding Hat.

- 36 **BITS / BRIDLES** - In all classes, unless otherwise stated, any suitable bit is acceptable.
- 37 **EAR RINGS / PIERCINGS** – in the interest of safety, no ear rings, piercings or visible jewellery should be worn whilst competing.
- 38 **BODY PROTECTORS** – may be worn and are recommended whilst competing in WHP/Eventing classes.
- 39 **SPURS/DRESS SPURS** must **NOT** be worn in any Show Pony / Intermediate Working Hunter / Intermediate Show Hunter Type/Intermediate Show Riding Type/Show Hunter Pony/Working Hunter Pony, M&M-WHP or any Ridden Mountain and Moorland showing class.
- 40 **SHOW CANES** – are not to exceed 75cms (30”). Hunting crops are permissible.
- 41 **HANDLES ON SADDLES** – are permitted in Lead Rein classes.
- 42 **MOBILE PHONES** – must not be taken into the ring.
- 43 **MEASUREMENTS** - The Equifest Show Committee reserves the right to measure any type of class by their official Veterinary Surgeon on the Showground unless exhibitors are able to produce a valid Height Certificate to the Veterinary Surgeon and / or Steward in charge on the day.
- 44 **STALLIONS** – in the interest of safety, stallions may only be ridden / driven / handled by persons over the age of **14 years** – with the exception of Small Breeds Mountain & Moorland stallions, where the rider / handler must have attained their **12th birthday** by the 1st January in the current year. Stallions are not permitted in any Young Handler, Equitation, Junior Ridden M&M, Lead Rein or First Ridden classes. Drivers of stallions must have an active, responsible adult with them at all times.

STABLES & ELECTRICAL HOOK UPS

- 45 **STABLING FEES / ELECTRICAL HOOK UPS ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AFTER MIDNIGHT ON THE 29th July 2022** even with a Doctor / Veterinary Certificate. Exhibitors wishing to request a refund of either stabling or hook up fees must apply **in writing** by midnight on the **29th July 2022**.
- 46 **ALL STABLES ON THE SHOWGROUND ARE TEMPORARY STABLES.**
- 47 **BEDDING** – straw / shavings are available for purchase at the showground.
- 48 **STABLING & HOOK UPS** – are subject to availability and will be issued on a “first come” basis. **Stables are NON-TRANSFERABLE. If you need to sell un-wanted stables, please contact the Equifest Office.**
- 49 **STABLE BOOKINGS** – **ALL** stable bookings **MUST** be accompanied by at least one entry per stable booked.
- 50 **HORSES / PONIES MUST NOT BE LEFT IN HORSE BOXES / TRAILERS OVERNIGHT.**

WORKING HUNTER / WORKING HUNTER PONY & PERFORMANCE CLASSES

- 51 **WRONG COURSE** - Any horse / pony taking the wrong course or jumping another fence after completing the course will be eliminated.
- 52 **REFUSAL** - If a pony/horse turns its quarters to a fence or has a complete turn round, or crosses its tracks on approach to the next fence a refusal will be given
- 53 **BOOTS** (including over-reach boots) are permissible in the Jumping Phase of any Working Hunter / Working Hunter Pony, Performance, Equifest Eventer classes and Show Jumping Competitions, but they must be removed before the conformation phase. **At no other time can a change of saddlery be permitted.**
- 54 **DISOBEDIENCE** – horses / ponies displaying disobedience - mounted or dismounted - during either phase will be eliminated.
- 55 **FALLS** - The fall of horse and/or rider anywhere on the course will result in elimination. The Rider may not attempt another fence but must leave the arena immediately on foot.
- 56 **EQUALITY OF MARKS** - In the event of equality of marks, the **TOTAL** mark from Phase One will take precedence, followed by the Manners Mark and then the Conformation Mark. If there is still a tie, the Judge's decision is final.
- 57 **MULTIPLE ENTRIES** - A competitor may ride more than one exhibit (maximum 2) in a Novice Working Hunter/Pony, Open Working Hunter/Pony, M&M Working Hunter Pony, Style & Performance, Competition/Potential Dressage Horse/Pony and WH/WHP Performance Classes, **but before the final phase must nominate to the Ring Steward which horse/pony he/she will ride for the final presentation of marks and rosettes.** Once the class has commenced there shall be no change of rider, except in a Championship.

REGULATIONS FOR SPECIFIC CLASSES

Unless otherwise specified in the individual class wording, the classes in this schedule will be open to the following horses / ponies:

PIEBALD / SKEWBALD CLASSES – these classes are limited to **Piebald & Skewbald** horses/ponies only. The ideal Skewbald or Piebald possesses a colour distribution of 50/50 colour and white markings, however acceptable patterns range from the predominantly white to the predominantly dark coat. The colour must be distributed on the body above the elbow and stifle; markings exclusively on the face are not acceptable. Only natural markings visible from the standing position are acceptable. The lesser of the two colours shall meet the minimum requirements of a single patch of colour located on one side of the body covering an area of 15x15cm.

MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND CLASSES – For the purpose of this schedule, all Mountain & Moorland classes are restricted to ponies registered in the Pure Bred Stud Books of: Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland or the Welsh Pony & Cob Society unless it is stated otherwise in the class wording.

NATIVE TYPE – For the purpose of this schedule, “Native” type horses or ponies are ponies that have a clear resemblance to one of the Mountain & Moorland breeds. These horses and ponies should be shown in a natural state, with full mane and tails and un-trimmed. They need not be registered as a part bred Mountain & Moorland.

TINY TOTS M&M LEAD REIN – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **5th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony to be shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein attached to the noseband only. Rosettes to all entrants.

TINY TOTS M&M FIRST RIDDEN – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **10th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle. Rosettes to all entrants.

TINY TOTS LEAD REIN SHOW PONY / SHOW HUNTER PONY – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **5th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony to be shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein attached to the noseband only. Rosettes to all entrants.

TINY TOTS FIRST RIDDEN SHOW PONY / SHOW HUNTER PONY – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **9th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle. Rosettes to all entrants.

RARE BREEDS – To be registered in any of the following Breed Society Stud Books: Cleveland Bay, Clydesdale, Dales, Dartmoor, Eriskay, Exmoor, Fell, Hackney, Highland, New Forest, Shire or Suffolk.

WORLD BREEDS – To be registered or eligible for registration in any recognised World Breed Stud Book. Registered Mountain & Moorland ponies are not eligible to enter this class.

DEFINITIONS FOR SPECIFIC CLASSES

AMATEUR CLASSES – These classes are restricted to exhibitors who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders/horses/ponies, livery, buying/selling or dealing as a means of deriving a source of income since 1st August 2020. Exhibitors must not:

- a) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling or dealing in a commercial capacity.
- b) Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
- c) Show a horse / pony owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm.
- d) On the day when an exhibit is competing in an Amateur class, Professionals Producers are not allowed to ride or work in the relevant animal. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the horse.

Animals and riders in **Home Produced** and **Amateur** classes must not receive any assistance from Professional Trainers or Producers on the day of the competition. (This includes preparation and training of the animal and the rider for the competition at the show). Exhibitors are encouraged to participate in training programmes but riders who have received individual training may not exhibit under that person.

HOME PRODUCED CLASSES – These classes are open to horses and ponies that have been stabled at home (without any paid assistance) or kept at livery on a DIY basis since **1st January 2021**. Horses / ponies must not have been shown or trained by a professional Producer or kept at full livery at any time during this period (except for service in the case of Brood Mares). To be owned / kept, produced, ridden / handled by a person who is not engaged in the training of handlers / riders / horses & ponies **OR** runs a livery yard / buys and sells any equine **OR** deals in horses / ponies as a means of deriving an income. Stud fees are acceptable.

NOVICE CLASSES – These classes are open to all horses and ponies that have not won more than **three** first prizes at any show in an **OPEN** classification on or before the **1st January in the current year**. Horses / Ponies that have **competed at HOYS, RIHS or Olympia** or won a Championship / Finals class at BSHA, BSPS, BSPA, CHAPS, NCPA, NPS, UKPH, SHB(GB), TGCA, TSR or Equifest will instantly be de-noviced. It is anticipated that exhibitors will enter in the true spirit of this competition.

PROFESSIONAL PRODUCER – A Professional Show Producer is a person who derives income from keeping and training horses and ponies for the show ring even if this is not their sole or main source of income.

Entry Fees 2022:

Members - £24 per class

Non-members – £26 per class

Concours - £10 per class

Eventing - £35 per class

Show Jumping - £10 per class

THE GALLOP EQUESTRIAN MAIN RING

AMATEUR CLASSES – These classes are restricted to exhibitors who for showing purposes have not engaged in a training programme for riders/horses/ponies, livery, buying/selling or dealing as a means of deriving a source of income since 1st August 2021. Exhibitors must not:

- a) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling or dealing in a commercial capacity.
- b) Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
- c) Show a horse / pony owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm.
- d) On the day when an exhibit is competing in an Amateur class, Professionals Producers are not allowed to ride or work in the relevant animal. No Professional Producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the horse.

Animals and riders in **Home Produced** and **Amateur** classes must not receive any assistance from Professional Trainers or Producers on the day of the competition. (This includes preparation and training of the animal and the rider for the competition at the show). Exhibitors are encouraged to participate in training programmes but riders who have received individual training may not exhibit under that person

Class 1 **AMATEUR LIGHTWEIGHT COBS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed and ridden by an Amateur Rider.

Class 2 **AMATEUR HEAVYWEIGHT COBS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed and ridden by an Amateur Rider.

CHAMPIONSHIP – First and second prize winners from classes 1 – 2 to compete during the Evening Performance. Champion competes for the **S K Wilson Plant Hire & Groundworks Supreme Amateur Championship**.

Class 3 **AMATEUR SMALL HACK** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms. To be ridden by an Amateur.

Class 4 **AMATEUR LARGE HACK** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 154cms but not exceeding 160cms. To be ridden by an Amateur rider.

CHAMPIONSHIP – First and second prize winners from classes 3 – 4 to compete during the Evening Performance. **Kerenelise Stud & Talanas Stud** Champion competes for the **S K Wilson Plant Hire & Groundworks Supreme Amateur Championship**.

The Amateur Hack Championship is kindly sponsored by the Kerenelise Stud & Talanas Stud.

Class 5 **AMATEUR SMALL RIDING HORSE** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. To be ridden by an Amateur rider.

Class 6 **AMATEUR LARGE RIDING HORSE** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 158cms. To be ridden by an Amateur rider.

CHAMPIONSHIP – First and second prize winners from classes 5 – 6 to compete during the Evening Performance. Champion competes for the **S K Wilson Plant Hire & Groundworks Supreme Amateur Championship**.

Class 7 **AMATEUR MAXI COBS** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 155cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. To be ridden by an Amateur rider. Top 10 to be presented in the Evening Performance. Winner competes for the the **S K Wilson Plant Hire & Groundworks Supreme Amateur Championship**.

Class 8 **AMATEUR LWT HUNTER CAPABLE OF CARRYING UP TO 12 STONE** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. To be ridden by an Amateur rider.

Class 9 **AMATEUR MWT / HWT HUNTER CAPABLE OF CARRYING MORE THAN 12 STONE** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. To be ridden by an Amateur rider.

CHAMPIONSHIP – First and second prize winners from classes 8 – 9 to compete during the Evening Performance. Champion competes for the ***S K Wilson Plant Hire & Groundworks Supreme Amateur Championship.***

Class 10 **AMATEUR SMALL HUNTER** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. To be ridden by an Amateur rider. Presentation of the top 10 during the Evening Performance. Winner competes for the ***S K Wilson Plant Hire & Groundworks Supreme Amateur Championship.***

RING 1

Class 11 **OPEN M&M SMALL BREEDS LEAD REIN EXCLUDING WELSH A** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **9th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony to be shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein attached to the noseband only. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 12 **OPEN WELSH A LEAD REIN**– mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 121.9cms. Rider not to have attained their **9th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony to be shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein attached to the noseband only. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 13 **OPEN M&M FIRST RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS EXCLUDING WELSH** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **12th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 14 **OPEN M&M FIRST RIDDEN SMALL BREEDS WELSH A & B** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **12th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle. Rosettes to all entrants.

CHAMPIONSHIP – First and second prize winners from classes 11 – 14 to compete.

Class 15 **MOTHER'S DREAM FIRST RIDDEN PONY** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 133cms. Rider not to have attained their **12th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony to be suitable for the child to safely ride off of the lead rein and will be judged on the suitability as a First Ridden pony. This is open to all types of ponies – but the Judge will not be taking conformation/type into account – only the safety and temperament of the pony.

Class 16 **M&M / NATIVE TYPE LEAD REIN EQUITATION** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **9th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony to be shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein attached to the noseband only. To be judged on riding ability only. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 17 **M&M / NATIVE TYPE FIRST RIDDEN EQUITATION** – mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their **12th** birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle. To be judged on riding ability only. Rosettes to all entrants.

2. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 10 at the Judge's discretion.
3. There is no set penalty for a pole down or run out but three refusals will result in elimination.
4. Fall of horse or rider will result in elimination.
5. There will be no mark awarded for conformation or manners, but a mark will be awarded for overall impression at the completion of each round.
6. In the event of a tie, the overall impression mark will determine the final placings. Should there still be an equality of marks, the jumping marks will be taken into consideration - the comparison beginning with fence one and continuing thereafter until a result is achieved.
